POOL HEATER REPORT

The General Board decided in the Feb. meeting to go ahead and install the propane heater rather than the solar heater due to the enormous installation cost of \$12-\$15,000 for the solar heater. C/A WILL BE IN HOT WATER THIS SUMMER!

Our thanks to Tim and Sue McPeak for their \$10 gift to help us install that heater. Our total giving is now at \$4,010.23, shy of our \$5,000 goal. In addition to the heater, we will have to build a room, on the side of the pool building to house the heater.

We are guessing that the bill for heating the pool with propane will run from \$500 to \$700 for a season. Rather than raise our rates from .50° for the two hours swim, we are hoping to receive contributions enough to cover this additional cost of operating the pool.
