To date, C/A has received \$2,377.14 from 13 area congregations and 18 individuals, including a \$1,000 anonymous gift. We know of at least one more gift yet to be received which will drive our total up higher. This year's offering, remember, will be used to do the fill-in work down at the ballfield. The C/A Executive Board voted to use the B-A-M money and this offering to do this work at a cost of \$5,000 - the new bid submitted since our last Chronicle when we reported that it would cost \$8,200. Bruce Barilla made a contact through the Pettrey congregation that allowed C/A to save \$3,200! A special thanks to Bruce and to everyone who contributed to this grand offering for 1988!
