Some of our readers have asked "Just what is this item we see in the financial report marked 'petty cash'?" Following is an explana-

tion of what our Petty Cash is used for and why we have it.

Petty cash is the operation funds for the Children's Home. It is our 'household money' and is spent on odds & end groceries, school supplies, entertainment, necessary clothing (ie. new shoes nylons for all these girls), all personal items here at the home.
