**LARRY POTEAT LEAVES C/A \$456,093.08  
IN HIS WILL!!!**

By far, this is the largest gift we have ever received – \$456,093.08 from the will of Larry Poteat, a personal friend since 1997. Larry lived in Roanoke and died April 15th, 2018; you have seen his name many times in the Chronicle, but never in such a grand fashion. THIS MONEY IS DESIGNATED TO HELP BUILD A GYM AND SIMILAR TYPE BUILDING AND CAN NOT BE SPENT FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE EXCEPT THAT! This means we can't use it for the general fund. Pending approval by the General Board in November and upon the unanimous recommendation of the Executive Committee, the money will be placed in a CD earning \$79,800 in 5 years. During this time period, we will be exploring designs and construction necessities. Coupled with what we have in the building fund, we will have almost \$600,000 to do this project in 5 years.
